### PRACTICE COSTUME SAFETY

Costumes shouldn't limit movement, hearing, sight, or ability to breathe, bark, eat, drink or go potty.

### THROW WRAPPERS AWAY

Aluminum foil or cellophane packaging can cause intestinal blockage and vomiting when ingested.

### WATCH THE FRONT DOOR

Even the calmest pet may try to escape, as too many strangers can be overwhelming and stressful.

### DOUBLE-CHECK PET ID'S

A collar and tags and/or a microchip can be a lifesaver if your pet happens to escape or become lost.
